The Resource Person highlighted the students on the fundamental human rights and the types of human rights. Human rights are like armour: they protect humans; they are like rules, because they tell how one can behave; and they are like judges, because one can appeal to them. They are abstract – like emotions; and like emotions, they belong to everyone and they exist no matter what happens. They are like nature because they can be violated; and like the spirit because they cannot be destroyed. Like time, they treat all in the same way – rich and poor, old and young, white and black, tall and short. They offer respect, and they charge the individuals to treat others with respect. **81 students were benefitted through this session.**

Human Rights Committee organized a Guest Lecture on 04.12.2018. Mrs. Sivagami, Advocate, Coimbatore Court served as the Resource Person and spoke on the topic "An Awareness of Human Rights". The Resource Person spoke about the need of an awareness of human rights in today's world. Human Rights' is one of the most 'talk' of an hour in today's society. The existence of that right as an "inalienable," universal, right of all people was asserted in the UN General Assembly's Declaration of December 1986.' Human Right is the right that every human being possessed just because he/she is being born as a human; irrespective of caste, creed, religion, sex, race, nationality or region. Being born as a human being is the only criteria to possess human rights. So one can say that human are the most gifted creature of the entire universe who possess all different kinds of rights as soon as one is born; whether he/she is being aware of it or not. We have all kinds of rights and responsibilities as being enshrined' in the constitutional provision as well as in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. But to get justice and to be sure whether one is living a dignified life, one should be aware of human rights concept first and then all kinds of rights that we possess.
